Chinchinim VP to focus on collection of dry waste

Has sought public participation in tackling garbage issue in village

Chinchinim panchayat in a bid to make the panchayat area garbage free has sought public participation in tackling the garbage issue, while focusing on weekly collection of dry waste in all the 11 wards.

Addressing the media after a special body meeting Chinchinim panchayat members led by the sarpanch, Valentino Baretto said the panchayat body has changed the contractor for garbage collection as the people were not happy with the earlier contractor. He said that the panchayat will invite fresh bids with three contractors approaching the panchayat.

He said the tender was awarded to a company by one Clinton Vaz who offered good services at a reasonable price and hence was given the contract. He said as garbage will be col-

lected on fixed days once a week with days being fixed at 2, 10, 17 and 25 of every month from 9 a.m. to 1.30 p.m.

He said the vehicles will be fitted with GPS tracking navigation for real time assessment of garbage collection. He also said that the vehicle will be fitted with a siren and only dry waste will be collected along with sanitary and diapers which will be free to start with and a nominal fee of Rs 20 per kg for diaper and sanitary pads.

He said garbage collection will be carried out simultaneously in all the wards which are divided in two with one vehicle covering ward 1, Caramorod, Minfol, Azmaddi, Bandfol, ward 2 Dandeavaddo, ward 3 Alleavaddo, Dandeavado, ward 4 Baida and Caritas colony, ward 5 Zoribath and ward 6 Durga.

While the second vehicle will cover ward 7 Sucaldem and Palmar Grande, ward 8 Bamado and Tolleaband, ward 9 Coddeavaddo and 2nd palvem,

ward 10 Deussua and ward 11 Secreamwavddo and 1st Palvem, ward. He urged the people to co-ordinate with the respective ward members for smooth collection of garbage while housing colonies will have to dedicate a designated collection point.

Baretto urged the people not to mix the wet garbage with the dry waste or else the mixed garbage will not be collected. He also urged public participation to prevent roadside dumping of garbage which is a major concern. He said they will first streamline the garbage collection within the village for making Chinchinim garbage free.

He also urged the villagers to keep a strict vigil on those littering the village and they can send photographs to the village panchayat and the panchayat will take action without revealing the identity of the sender.

Chinchinim p'yat to begin weekly collection of recyclables, non-biodegradable garbage

MARGAO: In a bid to provide better facilities to the villagers, the Chinchinim-Deussua panchayat has introduced a proper garbage management schedule during a special meeting held on Monday to discuss the issue.

Sarpanch Valentino Barretto said that the panchayat will collect garbage on the 2nd, 10th, 17th and 25th of every month, from 9 am to 1.30pm.

The panchayat has also appealed to the villagers not to dump their garbage on the roadside and not to burn it, as it is prohibited under the law.

"Burning of dry waste and plastic will attract fines up to Rs 5,000, under the Non-biodegradable Garbage Act, 1996. The dumping of garbage on the roadsides is a

nuisance that needs to be stopped," said Barretto, asking the villagers to be vigilant to prevent it.

The Sarpanch said that the panchayat used to earlier collect dry waste fortnightly, but the villagers were not satisfied with the system.

The panchayat has decided not to collect organic waste like food, eggshells, garden and mixed waste, heavily soiled plastic bags, medical waste, tiles, plaster and cement.

However, pet bottles, tetrapak cartons, plastic carry bags, paper, newspaper, books, cardboard, glass, hard plastic, metal and foil, clothes, shoes, leather items, rubber, thermocol, batteries, tubelights, e-waste, diapers and sanitary pads will be collected by the contractor appointed by the panchayat.

Chinchinim p'yat to collect dry waste from residences on 4 days in month

The Chinchinim village panchayat has resolved to collect dry waste from the households on four days of the month - on 2nd, 10th, 17th and 25th of the month through an agency Recycle.

Seeking cooperation from the villagers to the dry waste collection exercise launched by the panchayat body, Sarpanch Valentino Barretto said the panchayat has roped in a new agency Recycle after following the codal formalities since the villagers were not too happy with the previous system of dry

waste collection.

"We had received three bids for the dry waste collection after which the panchayat decided to zero in on Clinton Vaz and his agency Recycle. Unlike the past, the dry waste will be collected by the agency on certain dates, on the 2nd, 10th, 17th and 25th of the month," he said.

He said the collection vehicle will be fitted with Siren and GPS tracker, while asking the households to keep the dry waste outside homes, on/near the gate. "Homes with no road access should keep waste on nearest motorable road," he said, adding that mixed waste will not be collected.

Society/building dry waste will be collected from single point only, he said, adding that in case of new home, the owners may contact van driver or the ward panch member.

Making a fervent plea to the people to avoid burning of dry waste (plastic), the sarpanch has reminded that they may be liable to pay a fine of Rs 5,000 for burning, dumping, mixed garbage under the Non-Biodegradable Act 1996. "We request the people to be a vigilant citizen to stop this menace. People will be rewarded, names will not be disclosed if you provide us the photos/ videos of people throwing garbage."
